Here at No Worries, your pet's health is very important to us and we take every precaution to limit their chance of disease during their stay with us. Dogs that go to boarding facilities and daycare (especially during winter months) are more at risk of disease. Kennel cough and other upper respiratory diseases are the most common. Most infections are self-limiting meaning they resolve on their own without medications.

If your dog is affected with kennel cough, you may notice one or more of the following symptoms:

- a strong cough, often with a "honking" sound - this is the most obvious symptom.
- runny nose.
- lethargy.

### Symptoms of Upper Respiratory Tract Infection

The classic signs of canine upper respiratory tract (URT) infection are very similar to the symptoms of the common cold in people.

Dogs with URT infections typically develop one or more of the following symptoms:

- Sneezing
- Snorting
- Retching; gagging
- Coughing (deep, dry and hacking, or moist and productive)
- Production of pale, frothy foam from the mouth
- Nasal irritation (evidenced by scratching, pawing, head/face/nose rubbing and head-shaking)
- Nasal discharge
- Ocular (eye)

Therefore to help reduce their risk, we enforce yearly kennel cough and canine respiratory disease vaccinations, strict cleaning protocols, and utilize an air exchange and germicidal ultraviolet system.

We want to inform you of the possible risks and assure you that we are doing everything we can to keep our guests healthy.
